

Rick's Write &

Dear Church Family,

The following is from my newsletter article LAST April/May. It seemed appropriate for me re-publish this portion. I believe God was doing something even a year to 18 months ago within this church family to bring us to the decision that is before today. As is often the case, it is only after you begin walking in faith that you start to understand God's plan. (Bold print is my emphasis this year.)

I want to ask you to be praying about something. Since last November your church staff and the five newly elected Purpose Leaders have been meeting together, praying, and even fasting, with the goal that God would give us a clear vision for what this church is to be and to do moving forward. We have enjoyed our times together and we feel that God is moving and shaping our thoughts around his thoughts.

Here's the prayer request in three parts: 1] pray that God would direct the leadership of this church, and each individual member, toward a clear vision, 2] pray that God will be preparing the hearts of his people to accept the vision and unify around God's plan for us, and 3] pray that we will have determination and resolve to step out in boldness to do what God would have us do!

One thing that has never been a mystery about our vision: God is reconciling the world to himself through Jesus Christ, his Son. The work of Jesus on the cross, and his glorious resurrection make this possible. And he has given to us the ministry of reconciliation. (See 2 Corinthians 5:16-21)

I implore you to live your lives in the joy and hope and peace that springs forth from Jesus' resurrection. Jesus' victory over sin and the grave means that I, and all who believe, are victors! Live victorious lives even in the face of hardship because our God reigns!

Hosanna

"A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted.

'Hosanna to the Son of David!'

'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!' 'Hosanna in the highest heaven!'" (Matthew 21:8-9)

Hosanna. You've heard this word before, right? Especially around this time of year-for some of you, you are reading this on Palm Sunday, the day in which we celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. In modern Christendom, the word *Hosanna* has connection to praise or shouts of acclamation (some sources will even offer that as a translation); however, the original Hebrew meaning is more akin to "save us". The people of Jerusalem ARE looking to Jesus as their savior, but they are not praising Him, they are begging Him for help.

Why are they begging Him to save them? The simple answer is the oppression of the Roman Empire and the religious persecution they face from those leaders. They are not seeking eternal salvation for their souls, but rather freedom from political oppression. But thanks be to God that He does not merely give us what we want-He gives us what we need! Jesus could have easily commanded angels to swoop in and free the children of Israel, but His plan was far greater than just political upheaval.

How wonderful it is to serve a living God whose plan and will is far greater than we could ever begin to understand. Even though freedom from the Romans would have been welcomed by the children of Israel, the eternal freedom from sin and death is a far more magnificent gift. As we remember Jesus work of salvation, let us not take lightly all that Jesus did that we might enjoy life eternal with Him.
