



Dear Church Family,

In the span of time that encompasses the content of this newsletter — April and May, 2014, there is so much happening that my head is spinning just thinking about it. You are going to have to really pay attention over the next few weeks just to keep up.

There's Palm Sunday with a special choir presentation that night, our celebration of Christ's resurrection on April 20th, Operation InasMuch on May 3rd, a special series of meetings May 4th through 7th with Steve and Debbie Wilson encouraging us in our relationships, Mother's Day and Memorial Sunday. There's also Regional Bible Drill, an Easter Celebration for kids, an emphasis on North American Missions, and much work to be accomplished on Rodeo Polkville!

I want you to pray about it, realizing that the question you turn in might very well become the focus of a worship service, and we always want God to direct the focus of our services! Starting the Sunday after Easter there will be a place on the worship response card for you to submit your question. Please include your name in case I need to talk with you about specifics concerning your question.

Pray for me that I will be up for this challenge and that God will guide me in my study and preparation. And, pray for yourself that God will reveal some things to you that strengthen your faith and better prepare you to share your faith. At the same time, pray that we might have a humble and child-like faith even as it deepens with understanding.

Let me conclude by welcoming Thomas Pandolfi to Polkville Baptist Church as our pianist. God is good (all the time!) and the way he has orchestrated the events leading Thomas to us is nothing short of miraculous. We have already been blessed by God as Thomas has added his talent to our worship, and we look forward to many more times that God gives us together. It is obvious that Thomas is a blessing to us. Let's pray about how we might be a blessing to him!

A Word From Dale: This month I'm sharing a testimony. Not my testimony but a testimony about God working in the lives of a couple in our church - Jason and Susanne West. Jason serves as Rodeo Committee Chairman and he and Susanne are a great couple. Recently Jason sat down with Rick and myself and God touched my heart and blessed me as Jason shared how God is moving in his and Susanne's life. Over the past while Jason had been dealing with issues of keeping his Surveying Business going as well as other stresses. Jason felt the weight of the world on his shoulders and nothing seemed to be going right. It was during this time that Jason began to seek God more than he ever had before in his life and God began to speak into Jason's life like never before. During this time God led Jason and Susanne to give more of themselves to the Lord and in doing so they realized the pressures he felt before where dissolving and those that hadn't been resolved did not seem significant any longer. Jason praises the Lord for working in his and Susanne's life. As God continued to do His thing in their lives Jason and Suzanne began to want to give even more to God. They prayed about it and decided to seek out something they could do to minister to someone. The Lord laid a burden and desire on their heart to minister to the homeless in Shelby. After a lengthy journey trying to find the right person to talk with God led them to the coordinator for the Men's Shelter. Jason and Susanne found out there was no meal being served on the 2nd Saturday of each month. They knew God had opened this door for them to serve so in March they served the a meal at the homeless shelter. In preparation to serve their first meal at the Men's Shelter, Jason and Susanne mentioned to some people how the Lord was leading them and people began wanting to help. In a matter of a few days God put together a little team to help with the first meal. Elizabeth Davis helped them prepare the food and myself along with my girls and Tim Grier and Mateo went with Jason and Susanne to serve the meal. I want to tell you that we all had the best time with the men at the shelter. We spent about two hours talking to them and God blessed us all! God opened the doors for Jason and Susanne to minister to the homeless men and they have committed to fund and do all the work for this ministry but they are also willing for anyone to help. If God is impressing on your heart to help then let them know. Also in support of this ministry, PBC is going to start a fund so that anyone can come alongside of Jason and Susanne financially to help provide meals for the Men's Shelter. This is not a request for money and should not compete with your tithe to Lord, but we have already found that some want to donate to this ministry. Donations marked "Homeless Shelter Meals Fund" will be used to help with this ministry. Be praying for Jason and Susanne, pray for the homeless and pray for God to keep moving in his people so the love of God and the gospel of Jesus Christ can be shared. God Bless! Dale <><
