On the Subject of Camps, Trips, and the LORD

What a phenomenal summer we have had! The youth had the privilege this year to attend two distinctly different trips: Caswell and Mission Serve. Caswell provides a time of connecting with

other students and learning truth about God while having fun, while Mission Serve focuses on serving the LORD in tangible ways and learning truth about Him through those service opportunities. Ultimately, their end goal is the same: help students encounter God and grow in their relationship with Him.

Let's talk a little bit about our Caswell experience. This was my first time visiting Fort Caswell and so I wasn't sure exactly what to expect, but I certainly encountered God during that week! I think what stood out the most to me during our time there was the worship-there was a genuine excitement from the college students who were leading worship, a desire to share their passion for the LORD with the youth through their songs. And the students were all too happy in join in that excitement! Every time of worship was like a celebration of our LORD-the students would open their mouths and shout with their hearts. Our students responded to the hearts of the leaders and sought to commune in fellowship before our LORD-they were excited about singing praise. More than anything, I was so thankful for the times of worship at Caswell.

Now Mission Serve is an entirely different animal; most of your time while at Mission Serve is spent either working, preparing for the work you are going to do, or recovering from the work you have done. It is very easy in a situation like this to allow your tiredness and exhaustion drown out what God is speaking into your life. However, I have to say that the best aspect of this trip to Savannah was the commitment and dedication of our students. They refused to let anything hinder their work for God or to diminish their passion for Him. Rain? No problem. Little sleep? Piece of cake. 110 degree heat? No sweat... well, maybe just a little sweat. But seriously, these students poured every ounce of themselves into the work, knowing they were doing it for the LORD. You never hear a complaint or whine from our students and their number one desire on these trips is to share the Gospel and shine the light of Jesus.

Take some time to ask a student who went on a trip this summer what they loved about it. I can assure you that each student's answer will be different and encouraging. And, if you've never been on a youth trip as a chaperone, please let's change that. I promise you will not regret it and the experience will change your life.
