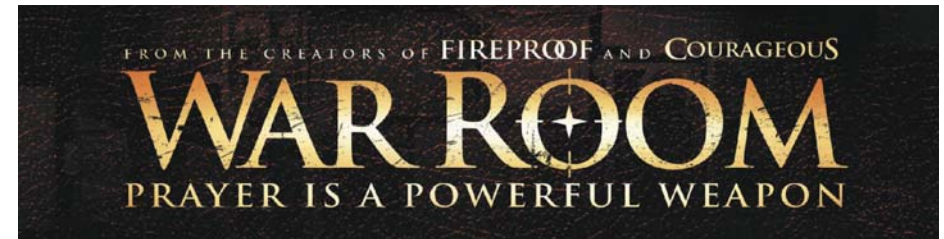
Thursday, September 17th

from the YOUTH minister

I am by no means a handyman. I did not grow up using tools or knowing how to build or repair things. In fact, I had never even mowed a lawn until last year when Rachel and I bought our first house. That being said the thought of going on a Mission Serve trip was more than a little overwhelming. Now, granted, over the past few years I have learned a few things and picked up a couple of skills here and there. But I had never really done major construction work.

Now to add to my apprehension about the trip, somewhere along the way, my application had gotten mixed up and they had assigned me as a construction captain-the leader of a project-and they had assigned me a wheelchair ramp to build. I have no idea how to go about building a ramp, I don't even know what tools I would need! I didn't know what to do; I often find in those moments when we have no idea what to do, turning to God in prayer is a good place to start. So I prayed, "God, You know I don't know what I'm doing. So if it is Your will, please take this project away from me and give me something that I know how to do. But if You want me to build a wheelchair ramp, I will-You just have to guide me every step of the way!"

I was still a little unsure about the whole thing and so I called the Project Coordinator, just to get an idea of what I needed to know, etc. She told me that I did not need to be a Construction Captain and that I would be better suited serving as a squad leader (I was ok with that!), so she switched me over and I no longer had to fret about how I was going to head up that project.

I knew in that moment that it had been an answer to prayer; however, what I find hilarious about how God often works is this: I was taken off as a construction captain to build a wheelchair ramp, but the project I ended up serving on was to build a wheelchair ramp. I think God wanted me to build a ramp, He just wanted it done in a different way. For me the greatest lesson I learned from this trip is this: God does not need us to be skilled, or to be the best, or to be amazing at everything. God needs us to be willing to step up and do the task; a willing heart beats skilled hands every time when God seeks to move in an awesome way.

Isaiah 55:8-9 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," declares the Lord. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts."
