Upside Down

This year we spent our Winter Retreat in Gatlinburg, TN at a cabin that we rented for our group. The theme of the weekend was 'Upside Down'-the focus of which was how once we choose to follow Jesus, He

turns our world upside down and changes our perspective away from ourselves.

We opened with talking about how Jesus' call impacts the relationships we have with one another, particularly our friends and family. Using the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet, we illustrated how important it is to keep the heart of a servant; not merely to do things for another, but to desire to emulate Christ and to demonstrate our willingness to sacrifice for others and to show genuine love.

Next, we discussed our role when it comes to our 'enemies'-whether they be actual enemies or simply people who irritate or annoy us. Jesus told us that we are called to love those who hate us and pray for those that persecute us; this is so counterintuitive! It is our desire to hate what hates us and to hurt who hurts us. However, in choosing to follow Jesus, we must be willing to follow a new path and to focus on different priorities.

Finally, we talked about 'the least of these'-those people we know who need help, but can offer nothing to us in return. This is exactly what Jesus expects of usreferencing the example Jesus gives of those who, when welcomed by Jesus, are confused because they did not do those tasks for Jesus, we see that that which we do for people who need our help is like doing it for Jesus.

We had some amazing food prepared by our team of chaperones and we spent our free day traveling through downtown Gatlinburg-be sure to ask the students about their experience with ants! Following Jesus turns your world on its head-but what a wonderful and amazing journey it is!
