Rick's Write

Dear Church Family,

On May 31, June, 7, 14 and 21 (Fathers' Day) I will be speaking on the four phases of childhood: preschool, children, middle school and high school. A few weeks ago I challenged us to think of every kid as being created in the image of God. I want to continue that thought as we journey through the life of a child from birth to high school graduation. I want to challenge families and the church to unite together under a single strategy to influence every child's life for Jesus throughout the various phases.

We only have so much time to pour into a young person's life. There are only 936 weeks between birth and graduation. The church has on average 40 hours per year to invest in a child's life. The statistical odds are greatly against a young person accepting Jesus if they do not do so by age eighteen. With so little time, and so much riding on it, we've got to be strategic and purposeful in what we do to impact these lives with the gospel!

A side benefit to impacting the lives of children and teenagers with the gospel is that moms and dads are then more likely to become involved in church, or to rediscover church. That means we will need to be more intentional than ever before in how we minister to and disciple these adults.

The strategy and curriculum is "Orange." You've maybe heard the explanation, but here it goes again: The two most potentially powerful influences in a child's life are **family** and **church**. Let's say the unconditional **love** experienced in a **family** is represented by the color **red** (love) and the bright **light** of Jesus discovered through the **church** is represented by the color **yellow** (light). When you combine **red** and **yellow** you get...**orange**. When you combine the **family** and **church** you get one **super powerful strategy** to influence a child's life!

There is only so much time! And the stakes are so high!
It's just a phase...so don't miss it!
