Dear Church Family,

Allow me a few moments of personal reflection. After all, my youngest is graduating from high school this month and heading off to college in August! Have you ever wondered where time went?

There have been so many precious times we have had with our children and God has blessed us so abundantly, but I have this nagging thought that I have not done enough of the right things and taught enough of the right lessons. I guess I'll just have to keep teaching even if it is by text message! (Sorry kids!)

The one thing I know for certain, and the one thing that consoles me in this, is that I know God's Spirit is with my children. The Spirit's presence is there always to convict and guide and direct. God goes with them. As hard as it is to comprehend, God loves my children more than even I do. They are, in fact, His children. He is, in fact, their Father. He created them and knows the plans he has for them.

Here's a couple verses from Psalm 127:

A Word From Dale:

Each week I have the wonderful blessing of teaching a great bunch of adults in Sunday School and for Mother's Day the lesson was from Proverbs 31:10-31. This scripture is a beautiful word picture of "Woman of Noble Character". Let's look at it.

Proverbs 31 says a woman with noble character has great worth. She is valuable! And I'm not making a joke that she costs a lot or spends too much money. She is irreplaceable! It says the husband of such a woman has great confidence in her. He never worries about her integrity, her decisions, her desires or anything else. He knows she is following after God and is faithful to him and their family. It says such a woman has the welfare and needs of her family on her mind all the time. She makes sure they are fed, she makes sure they are clothed, she makes sure things are ready when bad weather strikes. She never stops taking care of her home and family. In addition it says she has a tender heart toward the poor and needy. She has a heart of compassion and love. It says she enhances her husband and he is respected in the city because of her - who she is, her work and her service. She is wise and her husband and children love her and realize they are blessed because of her.

As I thought of this beautiful word picture that Solomon used to describe a woman of noble character I began to think of people. Now let me pause and say that I am not saying what I am about to say to get brownie points from anyone. I am speaking truth and there is a point to it so be sure to read on. As I was saying - as I thought of the word picture in Proverbs 31 I began to see faces and I began to tear up and realize how blessed I am! My wife is such a woman, my mother is such a woman, my sister is such a woman, my grandmothers are such women, my mother-in -law is such a woman, and there are countless others, including many of you, who are such women. As tears ran down my face God reminded me of something. He is the key! Verse 30 says, "...but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised." A woman who seeks after the Lord and is obedient unto Him is such a woman. But this is not all the Lord impressed on me. In that moment, as tears poured down my face, it dawned on me that the reason so many women fit the Proverbs 31 description is because GOD CREATED THEM LIKE THIS! I fully agree that all such women should be praised, but I believe that God should be equally praised because HE CREATED THEM TO BE AS THEY ARE. Then why aren't all women like this? Because all women are not following after God. Some have veered away from God's plan.

Now I want to give you something to do. Here it is - Praise the Godly women around you! And praise God for creating them as He did! Pray for them and pray over them. Shower them with love and thankfulness. And if you know other women who don't resemble this picture of a Godly woman then begin praying for them . Ask God to do a mighty work in their lives and restore them into the person He created them to be.
