Dear Church Family,

Sometimes simple things make the greatest impact. I have gotten very excited through the years about new programs and activities only to get frustrated with them before I even get through the instruction booklet. The flashy packaging and the bold claims for success get my attention, but then it's all just too complicated. Enthusiasm flickers and fades before the promo pieces go to press.

I am afraid that much of Christianity today has done just this. Bold claims. Easy to join. Then, we weigh ourselves and others down with so much "to do," and then heap on loads of guilt and shame.

All the while, Jesus says, "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10) And he said, "...my yoke is easy and my burden in light." (Matthew 11:30) And he also said, "...whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and is not condemned..." (John 5:24, emphasis mine)

I would be the last to suggest that we just do nothing. Boy, now that would be simple! But, many times we act as if our "doing" is going to save us, or secure our salvation. And out of that thinking comes the mentality that more is better; busy is better. And the more complicated and hard to figure out, the better. And then, not satisfied with our own "good-doing," we pass along a guilt treatment to those who we judge to be doing less.

Then, we put all this in a box, wrap it up real pretty, and call it "Religion." Religion doesn't save us. A relationship with Jesus saves us. Religion provides a formula by which we *survive*. A relationship with Jesus makes it possible to thrive.

You are going to hear that word, "thrive," a lot during October and into November. I plead with you to take this message to heart and participate fully in worship and in a small group. It is a simple message. And, sometimes simple things make the greatest impact.

A Word From Dale

We were not made to "Survive". We were made to "Thrive". I am excited about how God is leading Rick and others in our church toward a passion to "thrive". Digging deep into God's word is a Christian's life blood. As Christians, we will struggle to survive and we have no chance of thriving if we are not digging deep into God's word.

So how do we really dig into God's word? The first step is simply reading the scriptures. I often read a section of scripture and then I read back over that section in small chunks with an eye for key words and points of teaching. I try to get an understanding of the context of the scripture, which includes the audience, the culture, and the situation. I circle and underline important words and sentences and write notes in the margins of my Bible. At times I even study the meaning of key words or phrases in the original language of the Bible. Once I get an understanding of the message for the original audience then I look for application for me/us today. That seems like a lot to do for a small section of scripture, but what's the rush. I'm being serious. What is the rush?

Digging into God's word is not a race or a competition. It is a transformation marathon! 2 Timothy 3:16-17 says, "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work. (NLT) So digging into God's word teaches us truth, helps us identify wrong in our lives, corrects the wrong in our lives, and prepares us to do "every good work". In a word, digging into God's word "transforms" us! Another verse is Romans 12:2: Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect. (NLT) God wants to transform every person. I believe in miraculous transformations such as Paul's conversion or Zacchaeus and many others, but I can't testify to such a transformation in my own life. On the contrary, I can testify to transformation in my life as a result of the work of scripture. As it says in Romans 12:2 God is transforming me into a new person by changing the way I think. This has happened in my life as a result of my digging into God's word and allowing the Holy Spirit to speak to my heart through God's word.

I love you Polkville Baptist Church! You are and will always be precious to me and my family. We are praying for you to "Thrive" so that you will become more and more like Jesus and so you will help grow the Kingdom of God one transformed heart at a time.
